# Places available for the Lead & Hard Metals Specialist Applied Skills Programme (SAP) for April 2022 through to March 2023

## CANDIDATES WILL ACHIEVE THE FOLLOWING:

### LEVEL 2 HARD OR SOFT METAL ROOFING OPERATIVE

NOCN Level 2 NVQ Hard & Soft Metals Roofing Operative & City and Guild Accreditation in Traditional Intermediate Hard or Soft Metal craft. CITB funding is available for companies that are CITB Registered of £5000.00. The Level 2 hard or Soft Metals Operative is an 18-month Programme consisting of 30 days or 6 weeks training split into 1-week blocks delivered every 6 weeks, on completion of the training at the centre our assessors will come to site to complete the On-Site Assessment & Training for the NVQ, gathering evidence on knowledge and practical application of being a Lead or Hard metal operative.

### FULLY FUNDED LEVEL 3 HERITAGE HARD OR SOFT METAL ROOFING OPERATIVE

NOCN Level 3 NVQ Heritage Hard & Soft Metals Roofing Operative & City and Guild Accreditation Traditional Advanced/Heritage Hard or Soft Metal craft. CITB funding is available for companies that are CITB Registered of £5000.00. The Level 3 Hard or Soft Metals Operative is also an 18-month Programme consisting of 15 days or 3 weeks training split into 1-week blocks delivered every 6 - 8 weeks, on completion of the training at the centre our assessors will come to site to complete the On-Site Assessment & Training for the NVQ gathering evidence on knowledge and practical application of being a Lead or Hard metal operative.

CITB have also introduced the “Travel to Train Scheme” which give financial assistance for accommodation, food & travel, where 80% of the costs are covered through this scheme, CITB Grants can be used to offset the employer contribution towards this course. Funding available will significantly reduce the cost to you as an employer and allow you to support the next generation of Lead or Hard Metal workers. ### NVQ LEVEL 2 & 3 ON SITE ASSESSMENT & TRAINING (OSAT)

These options are designed for experienced workers without formal qualifications who want to obtain recognition of their skills by obtaining an NVQ Level 2 or Level 3 qualification without spending significant time training away from site.



An initial assessment is carried out by a qualified Assessor to determine whether you have the required skills to go directly onto OSAT or a few days formal tuition (usually between 5 and 13 days) at our training centre. Once the Assessor is satisfied you have the necessary experience, they will arrange to visit you on two/three occasions to assess your skills and competency to deliver hard metal work relative to the level for the qualification you are seeking.
